OYSTER HARBOUR TENDER CLOSE TO HOME

Regional civil contractors, APH Contractors, have just won a \$6.2 million tender for the largest single residential land construction of 103 lots in the Great Southern.

Bunbury firm APH Contractors were awarded the tender ahead to two large Perth based civil contracting firms, and will commence work soon at 'Oyster Harbour', a prime residential land development in Albany.

New to WA land development, 'Oyster Harbour' is a joint venture between a private developer, Heath Development Company, and the Department of Housing and Works. Upon completion, 'Oyster Harbour' will supply 2,500 lots providing much needed new housing for Albany residents.

APH Contractor project manager Shane Farrell said that it will be great to be working in partnership with the developers to create such an exciting land development project for Albany.

Since the initial land release in December 2006, 49 lots have already been snapped up and there is strong demand for the remaining lots in the first two releases.

Each lot of this innovative land development features smart wiring, retaining walls, water sensitive design, and usual services including gas.
